## Library Instruction Goals

- 3 sessions devoted to resources and research – Reference Collection; Book resources; Journal & Online Resources
- Library services Ask a Librarian; Consultations; Reference support; Interlibrary loan
- Build on your general knowledge of libraries and their organization and resources to refine and enhance your research skills

## Reference Collection

- Defined: A discrete collection of materials such as encyclopedias, dictionaries, almanacs, directories, or statistical sources as well as periodical indexes, and subject bibliographies.
- In Crumb Library 1<sup>st</sup> floor adjacent to the computer workstations and the <u>Reference</u> <u>Librarians</u>
- Material is for use in the library
  - Starting point for topic development
  - Identify resources
  - Provide factual or statistical support to your work

## Finding Reference Sources in Crumb Library

- Utilize the <u>classification numbers</u> to *browse* in general subject areas
- Search for resources in the <u>library catalog</u>,
   BearCat using <u>advanced search</u> to *limit* your search to reference materials
- Search BearCat using by subject heading
  - <u>Library of Congress Subject Headings</u> = the controlled vocabulary
