[Finding Articles]

- History subject page>Articles tab
 - Academic Search Complete – broad & recent
 - JSTOR – 100% full text, all periodicals back to beginning, but recent material embargoed
 - Project Muse – 100% full text, recent material only (maybe 15 years)
 - History Cooperative – confusing
 - Arts & Humanities Search
 - Alternative Press Index

- History Subject Page>Topics tab
- Online Collections
- Internet Directories – too basic
- Google – too broad, search for databases of your topic
- Scirus

[Archives collections]

- Find More > Archives
- **Directories and databases for locating collections**

 - OAlster – digital collections search tool
