





How to Get Articles

- Use a subject specific database to find relevant periodical literature
- Go to the Psychology subject page and use the Articles tab
 - PsycINFO generally citations and abstracts only, but some very limited fulltext
- Use ArticleLinker to see article availability



PsvcINFO-

- Indexes and abstracts over 2,400 journals, nearly all of which are peer-reviewed.
- Also has abstracts of books, book chapters, dissertations, and other scholarly documents.
- Citations and abstracts only except for 72 APA journals in full-text
- Some as far back as the early 1800s, but most from the 1900s on.

 - Go through the link on the library web site to go through the proxy server in order to....

- Database/Records/Fields/Data
- Descriptor or "Subject" Field -CRITICAL!
- Vocabulary
 - Natural language (how you would speak it)
 - Search terms (words you type in the boxes)
 - Author's words (some data fields anything goes)
 - Controlled (some data fields distinct & limited list)
- Thesaurus



The Whole Point

You want a list of GOOD, RELEVANT articles.

- What is GOOD?
- What is RELEVANT?

How do you do this?

- DISCOVER and USE good DESCRIPTORS
- Let the database limiters and features work for you

CONTROLLED VOCABULARY Psycinfo Thesaurus (Descriptors)

- Controlled vocabulary is a standardized list of terms used to organize information.
- Terms are often defined by a scope note and include relationships to broader (BT), related (RT) and narrower terms (NT)
- Synonyms are linked to the preferred term e.g. "sensation" use instead "perception"
- Access thesaurus through the "Search Tools" tab in PsycINFO



USE LIMITERS TO CONTROL RESULTS

- "DATE RANGE" for latest research use a range such as 1999-2009
- "LIMIT TO" check boxes for English and Journal Articles
- Methodology browse possibilities
 Check box for "Journal Articles Only"
- Other areas as appropriate (population, age, audience...)



Too many?

- Add more unique descriptors, connecting them with "and"
- Go back to the thesaurus to identify more specific terms (NT)
- Use more specific limiters



Too few?

- Reduce the number of search terms
- Go back to the thesaurus and find terms to broaden your search (BT) or add more synonyms (RT) nested with the Boolean operator "or" example: (self perception or self concept)



Not quite what you want?

- Check out the note defining your search terms – compatible with your meaning?
- Use keywords to search abstracts can you find at least one good article? Then use the descriptors from that article to search
