

Go through the research process explicitly and explain it all

- Topic Analysis
 - Can't ask easily for any of your required things: *useful, applied, or pitfalls*; have to evaluate the results lists on your own for this or ask indirectly if you have a large enough set of results.
 - Show reference resources both on Econ page and the general reference page
 - Gale encyclopedia search for "oligopoly" and "internal rate of return" and "transfer pricing"
 - statistics
- Newspapers and Magazines and Scholarly Journals and the issue of an applied discipline by non-academics (teaching, business...). Case studies.
- Show book searching in bearcats (managerial economics, economies of scale, public goods)
 - ILL details
- Show article searching and cover each database specifically - strengths and weaknesses
 - Compare Academic Search Complete and Business Source Complete side by side
 - Refer to the search histories sheet for search terms for demonstration
 - Database structured searching (records, fields)
 - Explain *and, or, not* and *truncation*
 - Intellectual property and access
 - Article linker
 - Business & Company Resource Center – "Exxon" and "supply and demand"
 - Discuss RePEc and its limitations – "long run average total cost"
 - Compare to Academic Search Complete and Business Source Complete
 - Discuss JSTOR and its limitations – "game theory"
 - Discuss Lexis/Nexis and limitations – "Exxon"
