

WorldCat “My Account” for saving search results:

When using the WorldCat database via FirstSearch, you have the option to establish a personal account that allows you to save search results. These results will remain available to you anytime you log on to your account in WorldCat. You may establish and save results in custom folders so that research for different classes is organized and easy to find.

Choose the “My Account” link in the upper right of the advanced search screen. Click on the new registered user link and follow the instructions to create your account. You may choose your own username and password.

As you search in WorldCat, mark the records you want to save. When you are ready to save results, access your marked records. Click on “Save Marked Record(s)” at the bottom of your marked records list.

To go back to your saved records at a later time, log on to your account in WorldCat and click on the “Home” tab. ABOVE the navigation tabs, you will see a link to your Saved Records.

All of your marked/saved records go into your default folder. You have the option to create additional folders and move saved records to another named folder. This is a good way to keep track of your work for different courses.
